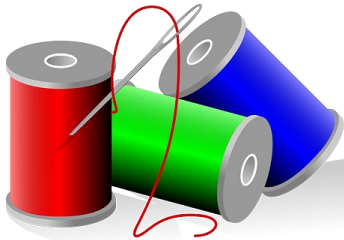

Our program was “Asking for Help when you hit a wall”. Hope the advice helped those who needed a little help finishing a project. We also finalized plans for the program and door prizes for the Guild Meeting on March 8. We were excited to have such a strong representation of our Ugli quilts. It was a fun chapter project/challenge. We enjoyed sharing it with the Guild. It’s amazing the variety of designs that resulted form many of the same Ugli fabrics. And not one quilt was ugly.

Robyn McGuffie will present our April 3 at Material Things at 5:45 pm—program on Kawandi. We welcome other chapter members to join us as we learn this new technique. Need to bring 1 or 2 pieces of 12 X 12 OR 18 X 18 pieces of fabric looser weave (muslin, old scarf) 4 pieces 4 X 4 for the Phula (The tassels on the corners) Random scraps of at least 3 X 3 or larger Larger needle (embroidery) 8 or 12 weight thread or whatever you want to sew with, & thimble and pins.

2025 National Teacher We have a national teacher. Her name is Jonce Smith. She will be teaching the techniques of the Studio 180 rulers. All the event will be at Bayou Oaks Baptist Church, 298 Joe White Rd, Monroe, LA 71203. July 24, 2025 Trunk show at 6 p.m. This is free to all members July 25, 2025 Hunter Star For those of you that have done a hunter star before this is a new technique that makes things much easier. The cost for this class is \$62.00. The guild will be paying $\frac{1}{2}$ of this cost so you will only pay \$31.00. You will receive a Book called Hidden Treasures and the Petite Hunter Star tool. When you sign up you will need to give me two checks. One for \$31.00 that will be cashed so you can receive the book ahead of time and pick you fabric. The other check will be for \$31.00 so that if you do not show up for class that check will be cashed to cover the additional cost of the book and ruler. If you do show up to class the second check will be given back to you before class. July 26, 2025 Lemoyne Star Again, if you have done the Lemoyne Star before, you will also find this technique much easier. The cost for this class will be \$54.00. The guild again will pay for $\frac{1}{2}$ so you will only pay \$27.00. This class has a pattern and a ruler. When you sign up again you will give me two checks for \$27.00 and the same goes for this class. If you show up you get the second check back and if not the second check will be cashed. If any guild member would like the bundle price that is offered to us, she will honor this, but you will have to pay the full price of \$62.00 or \$54.00. It is only members that get $\frac{1}{2}$ paid if they attend class. If you would like to check out the website it is: studio180design.net. I will start coming to the chapter meeting in March to start signing everyone up. I need to have the number of books, patterns and rulers known so that she can get them ordered and shipped to me so I can pass them out before class and you can pick your fabric. I have the book for the hunter star and ruler so I will bring that with me to the meetings, so you can see the different quilts that can be made with this technique.
