pictures on our page.

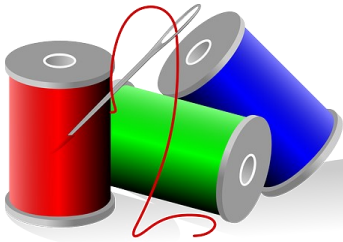

Moonlighters met in the Louis Locke of the Ouachita Parish Public Library and had a fun day!



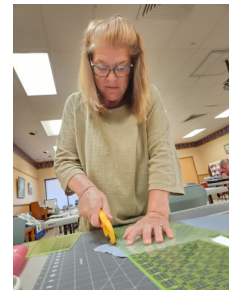
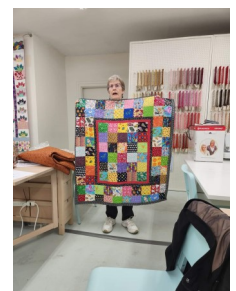

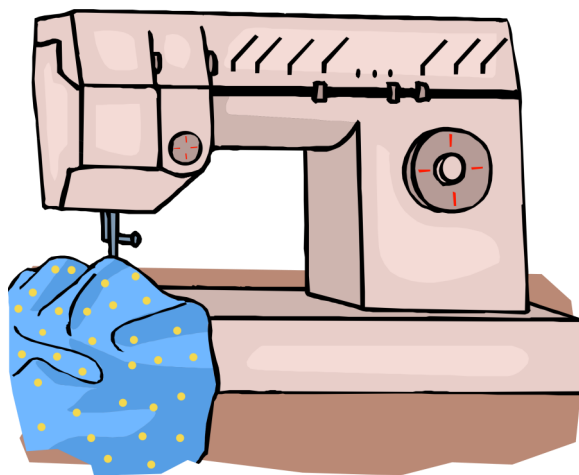
2023 NLQG QUILT SHOW FEATURED QUILTS
