We Sunshine will meet at Material Things on February 2, 2023.

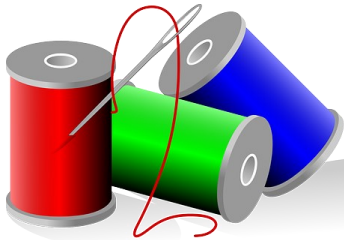

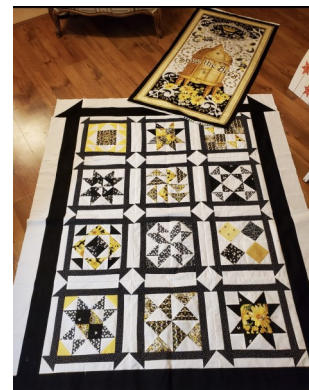
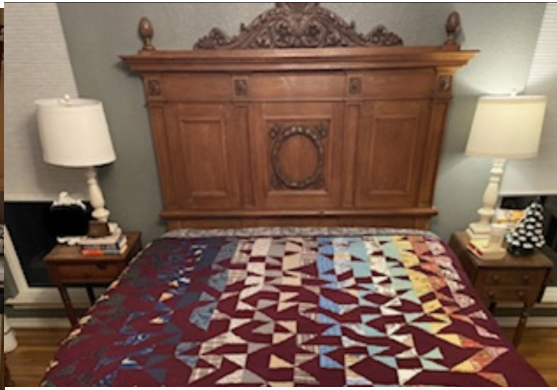
