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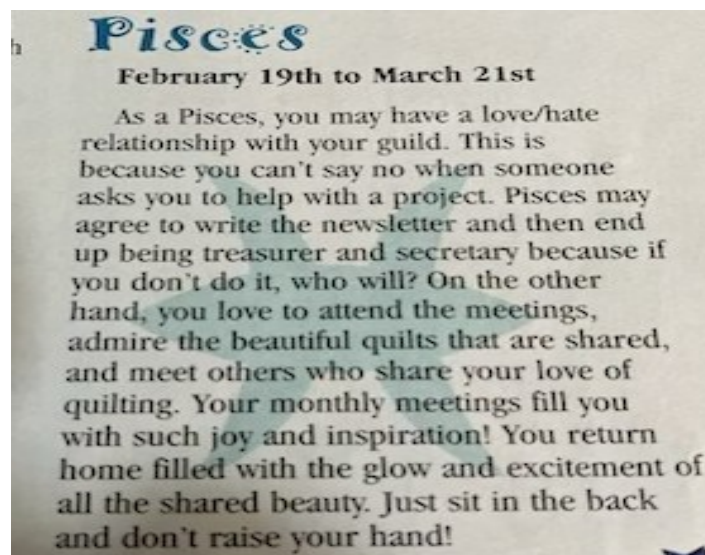
Hey fellow quilter's hope y'all are sewing well and ready for quilt show. February 27th and 28th.

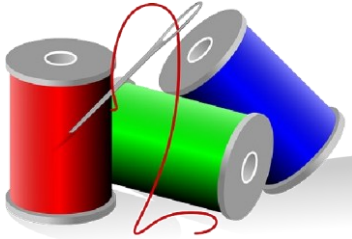

2. Bring quilts to the West Monroe Convention Center between 9 am and noon on Thursday, February 26th.
3. Quilts may be submitted by a friend.
4. PLEASE STAY TO HELP WITH SHOW SETUP IF POSSIBLE after submitting quilts. Ladders and wagons are most helpful.
5. Quilt pickup after the show will begin at 4:30 pm on Saturday, February 28th.
6. ASSISTANCE TO TAKE DOWN SHOW IS MOST APPRECIATED AND WILL BEGIN AT 4:00 Saturday.

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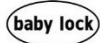
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
