We will meet on May 2, 2024 @ 1:30 P.M. @ Carolyn Rose Strauss Senior Center

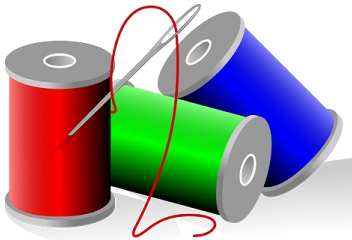

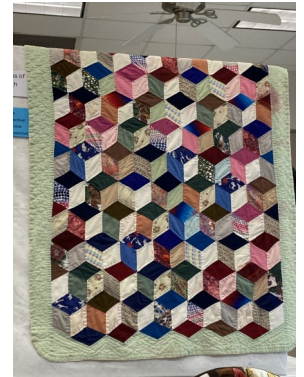
