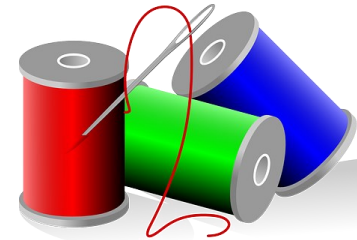


## Grateful Threads
