Policy & Procedure	The following change to the Policy and Procedures was approved at the Board Meeting October 28, 2023 VII Quilt Show (3 rd bullet point) “Only NLQG members or member’s relatives age 18 or younger may enter a quilt in the show. All quilt show entries must be presentable for all ages. Any entry displaying profane or obscene language, gestures, or images can result in a quilt being excluded from the show. The Quilt Show Committee will evaluate any entry brought into question for displaying obscene content, indecent content, or profane content as defined by the FCC Regulations to determine whether to exclude the entry from the show. Should the Quilt Show Committee agree by a 60% or greater vote that the entry displays obscene content, indecent content, or profane content as defined by the FCC Regulations, it shall be excluded from the show.”
