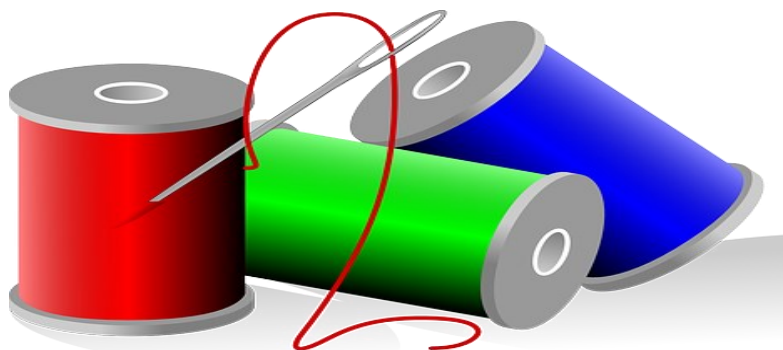


Ruth Davison will present the program for September She will talk about and show dolls that she makes to donate to the Grant Parish Sheriff's Department for children that are in a compromised condition

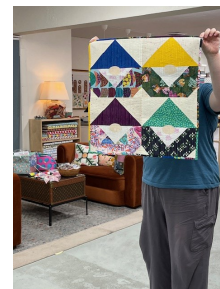

Policies and Procedures section:

I. FINANCIAL POLICIES

A. General Policies

Section I -The Guild

1. Two people shall count money received and sign a voucher.
2. Invoices or receipts are required for reimbursement.
3. One signature (Guild President or Guild Treasurer **or Guild Vice President**) is required for expenditures up to \$500.00. Two signatures are required for amounts over \$500.00.
4. Only guild members may handle money.
5. No signing of blank checks.
6. A receipt shall be given for all cash payments excluding raffles and other small fundraisers.
7. Bank statements shall be reconciled in a timely manner and a copy sent to the Guild President.
8. The Guild Treasurer shall deposit guild funds within the month.
9. When a checking account is closed/changed, all checks should be destroyed.

10. **Members of the North Louisiana Quilters Guild are considered volunteers and are not compensated.**
